

## Safe T.R.I.P. Tip

Test & Inspect the CO, Propane and Smoke Alarms installed on your RV weekly and each time your RV is taken out of storage. Replace alarms that don't work.

Replace all CO, Propane Alarms/Detectors over 5 years old and Smoke Alarms over 10 years old. The date code/replacement date may be on the back of the alarm.

Install only UL - RV listed CO, Propane and Smoke Alarm when you replace alarms. Add these alarms on older RV's to protect your family and friends.

**P**revent accidents by teaching family and friends about the operation of the alarms and other safety equipment installed on your RV. Never ignore a sounding alarm.

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## ARE YOUR SAFETY ALARMS OUTDATED?

The useful life of Safe-T-Alert and CCI Carbon Monoxide and Propane Gas Alarms/Detectors is 5 years. Smoke Alarms have a 10 year useful life.

## Carbon Monoxide & Propane Gas Alarms/Detectors

Replace Any CO and Propane Alarms/Detectors if;

- The CO Alarm/Detector is over 5 years old.\*
- The Propane Alarm/Detector is over 5 years old.
- The Alarm/Detector fails to test properly.

**Important!** Only install CO and Propane alarms/detectors that are UL® listed for Recreational Vehicle Use.

## **Smoke Alarms**

Replace the Smoke Alarm if;

- The Smoke Alarm is over 10 years old.
- The Smoke Alarm fails to test properly.

**Important!** Only install Smoke Alarms that are UL<sup>®</sup> listed for Recreational Vehicle Use.
